EON WAVEBUOY DEPLOYMENT

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that commencing on Monday 17 July 2017 (or as soon as circumstances permit) a Monitoring Buoy will be deployed in position:

Latitude 53° 38.19' N Longitude 00° 15.84' E

The yellow buoy, painted in accordance with IALA, has a flashing amber LED on top of the aerial.

The device will be deployed by the vessel “**PRECISION 1**” (length 12m and beam 6m) at approximately 1300 and will take one hour to complete.

MARINERS ARE REQUIRED to navigate with caution in this area and pass at a reduced speed to avoid creating a wash during deployment operations.

Once deployed the buoy will be serviced regularly throughout its deployment period.

The “**PRECISION 1**” will display the lights and signals prescribed in the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will liaise with VTS Humber and maintain a listening watch on VHF channels 14 and 16.
