RIVER HUMBER

HALTON MIDDLE – GAS PIPELINE STABILISATION WORKS

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that commencing Tuesday 13th February 2018 (or as soon as circumstances permit) and continuing for a period of approximately four days, stabilisation works will be carried out on the No. 6 (centre) gas pipeline which crosses the River Humber between Thorngumbald and Skitter Haven.

The 33 metre anchor handling tug '**VOE VANGUARD**' will be engaged in the work laying loose fill stone and 4 tonne filter bags around the Eastern (Thorngumbald) end of the pipeline outside of the main navigational channel.

The '**VOE VANGUARD**' will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 16 and 12.

MARINERS ARE WARNED to exercise care and caution in the area and to give the '**VOE VANGUARD**' as wide a berth as possible, passing at the SLOWEST POSSIBLE SPEED to avoid creating a wash.
