HUMBER APPROACHES

UNEXPLODED ORDNANCE INVESTIGATION

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that a potential Unexploded Ordnance (pUXO) investigation will commence on Monday 15th May and will be ongoing for approximately 12 weeks. The purpose of the works is to remove any identified UXO prior to the commencement of the main construction works relating to Hornsea Wind Farm.

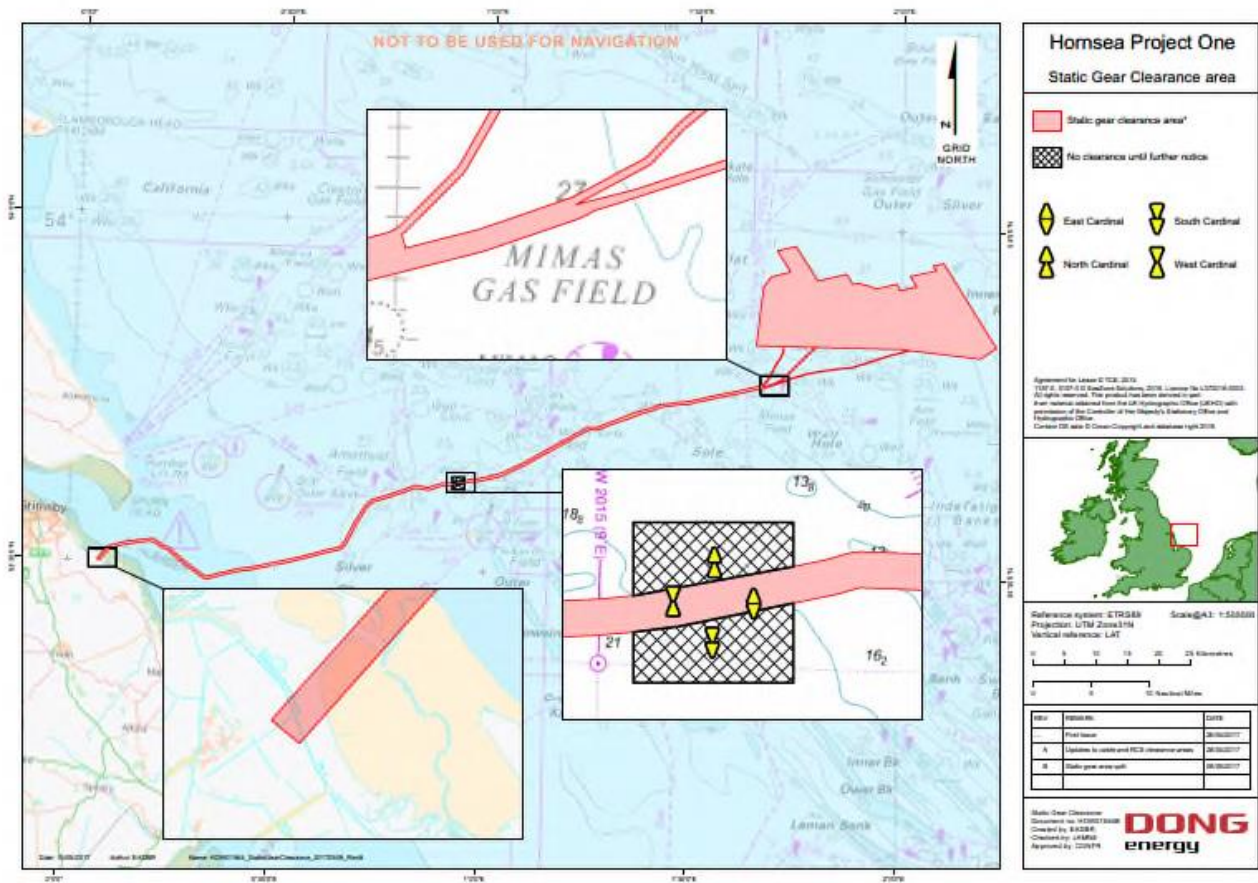
The works will begin at the Eastern section of the area indicated on the chart below and proceed West.

The vessel '**SMIT KAMARA**' (71m loa) will carry out the operation and will be deploying ROV equipment which will restrict its ability to manoeuvre.

The '**SMIT KAMARA**' will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 14 and 16.

MARINERS ARE REQUESTED to maintain a safe distance of 500 metres and pass at reduced speed.

MARINERS ARE FURTHER REQUESTED that anybody with prior knowledge of any potential objects submerged or moored on the seabed within the survey area that could cause hazard or damage to the vessel and equipment advise the Projects Fishing Industry Liaison Officer of their position and nature.
