HULL ROADS - SMALL CRAFT FLOTILLA

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that on Saturday 13 May 2017 a flotilla of more than twenty small craft and historic sailing barges will proceed in formation from Hessle to Hull Marina. There will also be a fire tug in attendance with water cannons in operation.

The craft will assemble by the Hessle slipway at approximately 1000 hrs and proceed to Hull Marina scheduled for 1030 hrs.

Humber Rescue craft will act as guard vessel and safety craft with a Police Launch assisting.

All craft in the flotilla will work VHF channel 08 for coordinating purposes and monitor VHF channel 12. Lead craft will inform VTS on commencement and completion of flotilla activities.

MARINERS ARE REQUESTED to keep a sharp lookout for this event and to exercise care and caution when navigating in the vicinity.
