CLOSURE AND REPAIR OF OCEAN LOCK, GOOLE APPROACH JETTY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Middle Pier Approach Jetty, Goole is out of use. Essential repair works will take place commencing 1200 hrs 18 May 2017. The repairs are expected to take up to 48 hours to complete around the low water periods.

A Humber Workboats vessel will be engaged in the work and will maintain a listening watch on VHF CH14.

During the period of repairs Goole Docks will be utilising Victoria Lock and will only use Ocean Lock for vessels 'running the lock'. Subsequently a reduced tidal window for inbound traffic is envisaged and contact should be made with the Assistant Dock Master at Goole on 01405 721128 to ensure lock availability.

MARINERS ARE WARNED to exercise care and caution when approaching Ocean Lock.
