RIVER HUMBER

IMMINGHAM DOCK – FLOOD GATE CONSTRUCTION WORKS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that commencing today, Friday 08 September 2017 (or as soon as circumstances permit) construction works are being carried out on Immingham Dock flood gates and that a temporary 4 metre structure is in place on the west outer gate position which has secure fittings protruding over the lock side. This protrusion encroaches over the lock side by 10 centimetres.

The temporary structure will be transferred to the East outer gate position on Saturday 09 September (or as soon as circumstances permit) with a similar protrusion.

On completion of the works (Tuesday 12 September or as soon as circumstances permit) the structure will be completely removed.

The remaining concrete structures will form the access to the new flood gates and will be protected by permanent fendering. These works are planned to take place on or around, Saturday 16 and Sunday 17 September.

MARINERS ARE REQUESTED to navigate with extreme caution in proximity to the works.

MARINERS ARE FURTHER ADVISED to liaise with the Immingham ADM on VHF Channel 19 or 68 to ascertain the latest status of the works.
