## RIVER TRENT

### GROUND INVESTIGATION WORKS AT KEADBY POWER STATION

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> February 2019 (or as soon after as circumstances permit), for a period of approximately five days, ground investigation works will be conducted at the Keadby Power Station outfall.

The work boat **JADE LIFT** (Loa 27m Beam 6.7m) will be carrying out the works. The work boat will be moored alongside the outfall and conduct a series of ground probes each day between the hours of 0800 and 1800. The work boat will be moored at AWS Keadby outside of these working hours and will have a standby safety vessel in attendance at all times.

The **JADE LIFT** will be manned throughout the operation and will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea. The work boat will also maintain a listening watch on VHF channels 17 and 15.

**MARINERS ARE REQUESTED** to contact the **JADE LIFT** before passing and to reduce speed to avoid creating a wash.
