RIVER HUMBER

SURVEY WORK

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that on Friday 27 October 2017 (or as soon after as circumstances permit), for a period of up to two months, survey works will be carried out in the following areas:

- Bathymetry survey around Read's Island - commencing on 27 October for four days.
- 250m spaced survey lines running bank to bank from Humber Bridge eastwards to Cleethorpes – commencing on completion of bathymetry survey until 13 December.

The survey works will be conducted by “**SENTRY III**” an 8m yellow Cheetah catamaran which will be operating out of Hull Marina, 3 hours either side of High Water.

The “**SENTRY III**” will liaise with VTS Humber advising of their movements, but whilst surveying remain fully manoeuvrable and will not impede the passage of any commercial vessel.

MARINERS ARE REQUIRED to navigate with caution in these areas.
