UPPER AND RIVER HUMBER

ADCP TIDAL FLOW SURVEY OPERATIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that commencing Thursday 5th January 2017 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) and continuing for a period of about 2 days, tidal flow survey operations will be carried out in the UPPER HUMBER, and commencing Thursday 12th January (or as soon after as circumstances permit) and continuing for a period of about 5 days, tidal flow survey operations will be carried out in the two locations on the River Humber detailed below:

- 1) UPPER HUMBER – 333 metres West of the No. 29 Light Float:

Position: N 53° 42.483' W 0° 27.824' (WGS 84)

- 2) MIDDLE HUMBER – 100 metres West of the FH6 Light Buoy:

Position: N 53° 40.023' W 0° 12.079' (WGS 84)

The 8 metre catamaran '**TRACER 4**' will be engaged in the work and will be anchored in each of the above positions for 12 to 13 hours whilst the data is collected.

The '**TRACER 4**' will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 16, 12 and 15.

MARINERS ARE WARNED to exercise care and caution in the area and to give the '**TRACER 4**' as wide a berth as possible, passing at the SLOWEST POSSIBLE SPEED to avoid creating a wash.
