

NOTICE TO MARINERS

RIVER HUMBER

HULL ROADS - EAST MIDDLE - SHOAL WATER

MARINERS ARE WARNED that a survey carried out on the 14th January 2021 shows the following: -

 Depths of between 5.1 metres and 5.5 metres below Chart Datum have encroached up to 22 metres into the Southern edge of the channel from 120 metres to 500 metres upstream of the East Middle Light Buoy.

Deeper water exists to the North in this vicinity.

 Depths of between 4.0 metres and 5.5 metres below Chart Datum have encroached up to 80 metres into the Southern edge of the channel from 380 metres upstream of the No. 22 Hook Light Buoy to the No. 24 Lower West Middle Light Buoy.

Deeper water exists to the North in this vicinity.

3) Depths of between 4.9 metres and 5.5 metres below Chart Datum have encroached up to 5 metres into the Northern edge of the channel from the No. 21 Hebbles Light Buoy to 115 metres downstream of the No. 21 Hebbles Light Buoy.

Deeper water exists to the South in this vicinity
