ALEXANDRA DOCK, GREEN PORT HULL – CHANGES TO AIDS TO NAVIGATION

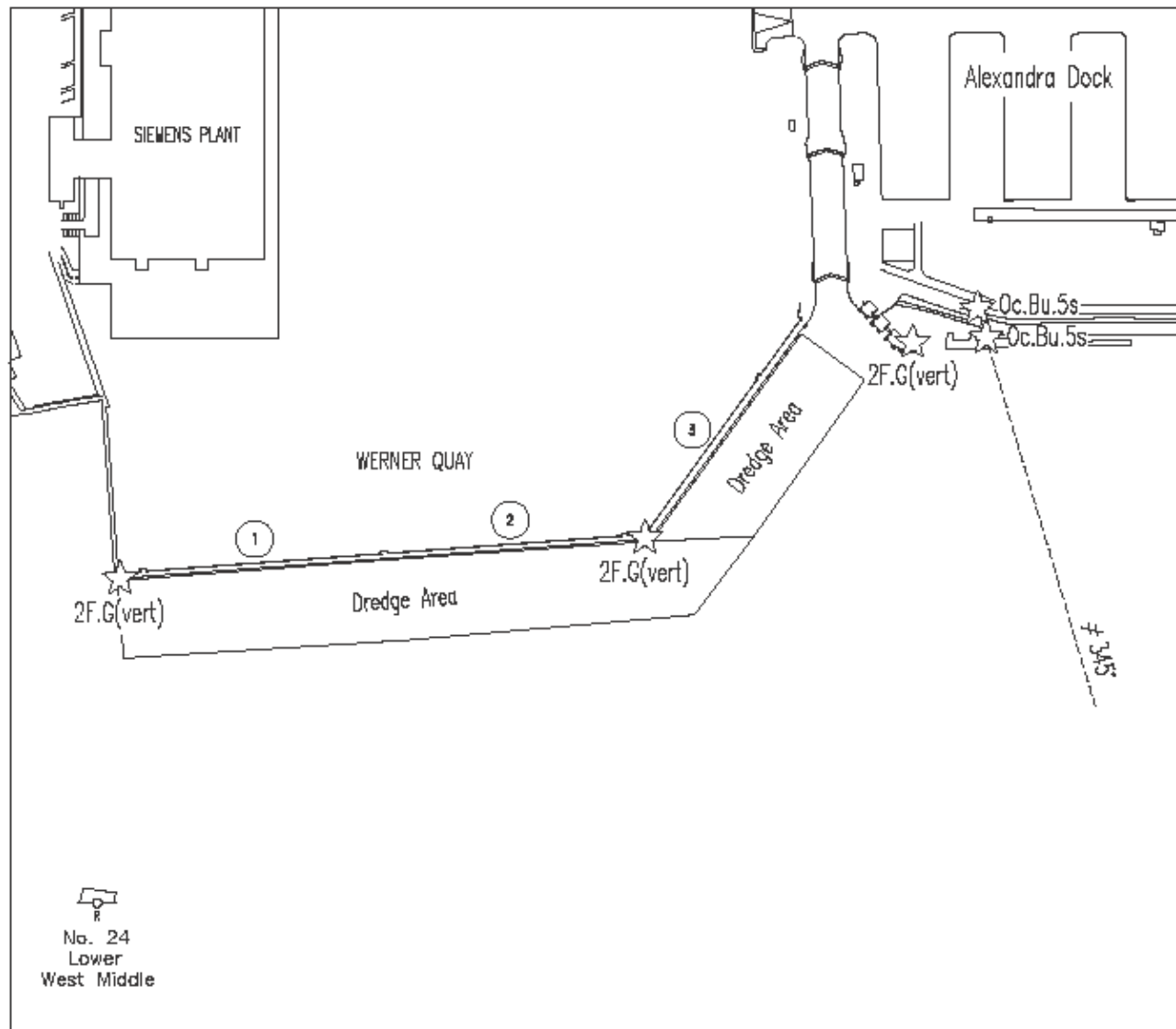
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that new Aids to Navigation have been established at Alexandra Dock, and there have been alterations to existing Aids to Navigation. New Aids to Navigation have been established to mark the limits of the newly built Werner Quay. There have been alterations to the Front and Rear Transit Lights for Alexandra Dock Approaches.

New Aids to Navigation:

- Alexandra Dock South West Corner –
 - Position – Lat. 53°44'27.0"N, 000°18'20.88"W
 - Light Characteristic – 2 F G (vert)
 - Steel Post
- Alexandra Dock South East Corner –
 - Position – Lat. 53°44'27.72"N, 000°17'58.32"W
 - Light Characteristic – 2 F G (vert)
 - Steel Post

Alterations to existing Aids to Navigation

- Alexandra Dock Front Transit –
 - Position – Lat. 53°44'32.52"N, 000°17'43.44"W
 - Light Characteristic – Oc Bu 5s
 - Yellow Triangle
- Alexandra Dock Rear Transit –
 - Position – Lat. 53°44'33.24"N, 000°17'43.8"W
 - Light Characteristic – Oc Bu 5s
 - Yellow Triangle
- The lights are on a bearing of 345 degrees.
