RIVER HUMBER

HAWKE CHANNEL - SHOAL WATER

MARINERS ARE WARNED that a survey carried out on the 12th September 2016 shows that depths of less than 9.7 metres below Chart Datum have encroached up to 20 metres into the South side of the Hawke channel extending from 190 metres to 625 metres upstream of the No. P4 Light Buoy.

Masters of Very Large Vessels (VLS) should take these depths into account when preparing passage plans as they may be impeded by the encroachment.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that Notice to Mariners No. H. 39/2016 is hereby cancelled.
