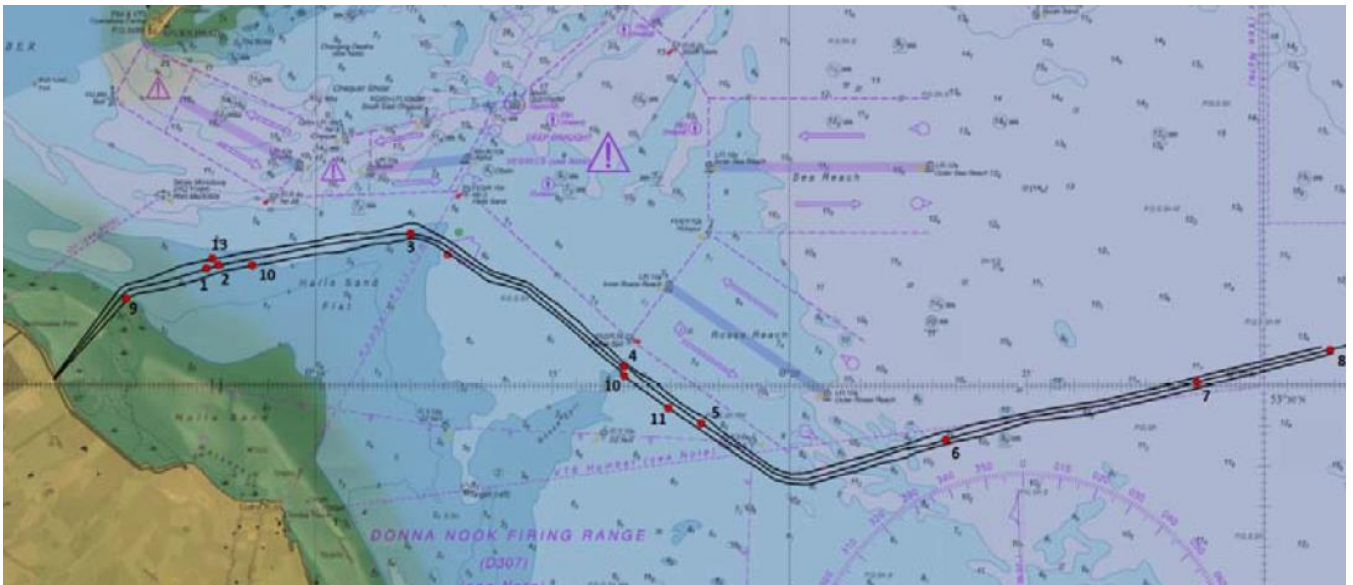

HORNSEA WIND FARM PROJECT ONE – REMEDIAL CABLE LAYING OPERATIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that commencing Sunday 18th August 2019 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) for a period of two weeks, remedial cable laying operations will be carried out as part of the Hornsea Offshore Wind Farm (Project 1) throughout the corridor shown below:



The 37 metre Multi-Cat vessel '**COASTAL CHALLENGER**' (call sign PBOC) and 21m survey vessel '**GEOSURVEYOR XI**' (call sign 2GRS3) will be engaged in the works.

The '**COASTAL CHALLENGER**' and '**GEOSURVEYOR XI**' will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 14 and 16.

MARINERS ARE REQUESTED to pass at reduced speed to avoid creating a wash and **ARE FURTHER REQUESTED** to maintain a safe distance of 500m.
