RIVER HUMBER

LOWER AND UPPER HUMBER – SURVEY OPERATIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that trawl surveys will be taking place at the following locations:

- Mudflats at the mouth of Hedon Haven (53°43.5'N 0°14.4'W) on Thursday 13 October, between 1600 and 1830.
- Southeast side of Redcliffe Sand (near Chalderness) (53°41.7'N 0°29.8'W) on Tuesday 18 October, between 0745 and 0915.

The 6m RIB '**HULL UNI ONE**' (call sign MJTF9) will be engaged in the work, and will be required to conduct six trawls at each location. The trawl itself will consist of a 1.5m beam trawl net, which will be streamed approximately 25m from the stern of the vessel. Each trawl run will be 300m in length.

MARINERS ARE ALSO ADVISED that in addition, the '**HULL UNI ONE**' will also be conducting a survey at the following location:

- Southeast of Redcliffe Sand (near Chalderness) (53°41.7'N 0°29.8'W) on Monday 17 October between the hours of 1330 and 1600 (over the Low Water period).

This survey involves streaming a 30m long seine net out from the sandbar and back to form a horseshoe, before hauling the net back in and will need to be completed three times.

The '**HULL UNI ONE**' will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 16, 12 and 15.

MARINERS ARE WARNED to exercise care and caution in the area of any survey and to pass the '**HULL UNI ONE**' at a **REDUCED SPEED** to avoid creating a wash.
