HORNSEA WIND FARM PROJECT TWO – ORDNANCE DETONATION

MARINERS ARE WARNED that commencing Friday 30th August 2019 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) for a period of five days, ordnance detonation operations will be carried out as part of the Hornsea Offshore Wind Farm (Project 2) works in the following positions:

The 33 metre Multi-Cat vessel '**VOE VANGUARD**' (call sign MBEN9) and 34m standby safety vessel '**FAXABORG**' (call sign YJQJ6) will be engaged in the works.

The '**VOE VANGUARD**' and '**FAXABORG**' will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 14 and 16.

MARINERS ARE REQUESTED to pass at reduced speed to avoid creating a wash and **ARE FURTHER REQUESTED** to maintain a safe distance of 500m.
