RIVER TRENT

GAINSBOROUGH BRIDGE – SURVEY

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that on Tuesday 25 October 2016 (or as soon after as circumstances permit), and continuing for approximately two days, a scanning survey of Gainsborough Stone Bridge will be undertaken.

The scope of the survey involves a laser scan of the bridge structure visible above the waterline and at low water a sonar scan of the bridge structure below the water line at high water. An inflatable 5m Zodiac acting as survey and safety boat will be in attendance. Warning signs will be placed upstream and downstream of the bridge and the team will maintain a listening watch on VHF channels 17 and 16.

VTS Humber will be advised prior to and on completion of operations each day.

MARINERS ARE REQUESTED to exercise particular care and caution when navigating in the area and to pass the works at slow speed to avoid creating a wash.
