SURVEY OPERATIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a trawl survey will be taking place at the following location:

- Mudflats at the mouth of Hedon Haven (53°43.5'N 0°14.4'W) on Monday 09 October, between 0815 and 1000.

The 6m RIB '**HULL UNI ONE**' (call sign MJTF9) will be engaged in the work, and will be required to conduct six trawls at this location. The trawl itself will consist of a 1.5m beam trawl net, which will be streamed approximately 25m from the stern of the vessel. The trawl run will be 300m in length.

The '**HULL UNI ONE**' will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 16, 12 and 15.

MARINERS ARE WARNED to exercise care and caution in the area of the survey and to pass the '**HULL UNI ONE**' at a **REDUCED SPEED** to avoid creating a wash.
