

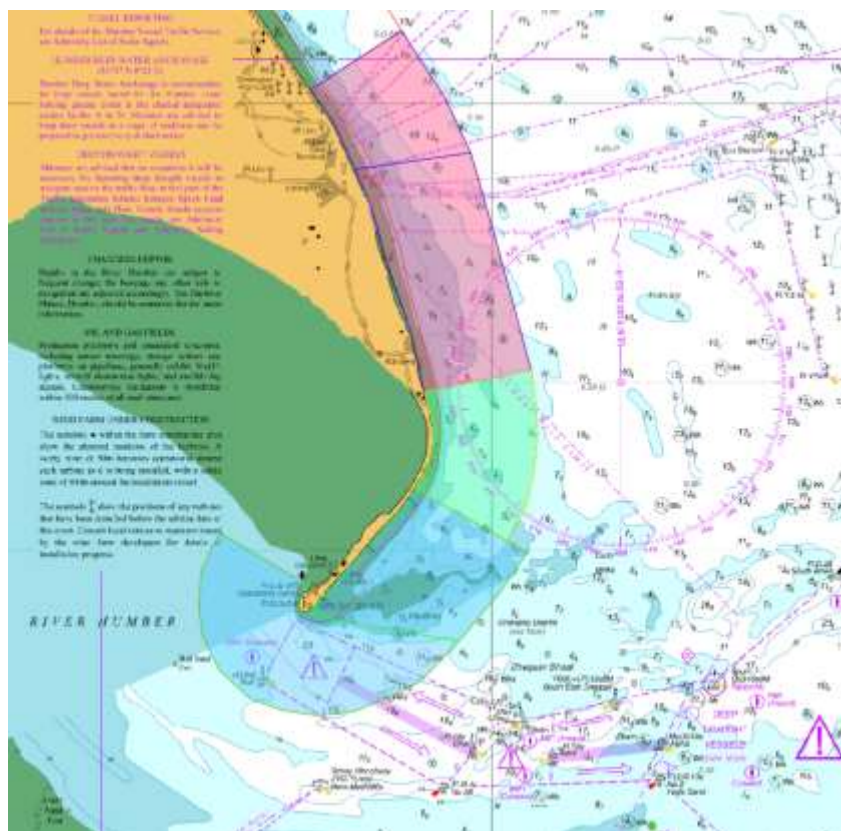
NOTICE TO MARINERS

HUMBER APPROACHES

SURVEY OPERATIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that commencing on Saturday 29 October 2016 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) for a period of approximately six weeks, survey operations will be carried out in the Humber approaches as shown below.



The 15 metre survey catamaran '**MV TITAN ENDEAVOUR**' will be engaged in the work and when surveying, will be using a multibeam echosounder, a drop camera and will also be conducting benthic sediment grab samples, during which time she will be restricted in her ability to manoeuvre.

'**MV TITAN ENDEAVOUR**' will liaise with VTS Humber prior to conducting the survey within the Traffic Separation Scheme (TSS) to ensure that the survey is only conducted during periods when no vessels are transiting the area.

The 'MV TITAN ENDEAVOUR' will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 16 and 14.

MARINERS ARE WARNED to exercise care and caution in the area and to pass the 'MV TITAN ENDAVOUR' at a REDUCED SPEED to avoid creating a wash.
