## **RIVER TRENT**

### **DERRYTHORPE LAY-BY JETTY - REFUBISHMENT WORK**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that commencing Monday 21 November 2016 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) and continuing for a period of 10 days refurbishment works will be carried out at the Derrythorpe lay-by jetty.

The works involve the refurbishment of the dolphin and replacement of the timber fenders.

The works will involve men working from a basket and be carried out by the Crane Barge “**COLLINGHAM**” who will layby on station outside of operational hours. The operation will be carried out during daytime only and a Night Watchman will be on board the “**COLLINGHAM**”, during non-working hours.

The “**COLLINGHAM**” will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea.

**MARINERS ARE ADVISED** to exercise care and caution in the area and to make early contact with “**COLLINGHAM**” on the appropriate VHF channel (Ch 6 or Ch17) before approaching the site, and a slow speed will be required.
