**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> October 2020 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) and continuing for a period of two days, removal works will commence on the Chalderness Illuminated tide board structure in the following position:

Latitude 53° 41.833' N

Longitude 0° 28.512' W

The workboat '**REBECCA-M**' will be engaged in the works and will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12.

**MARINERS ARE ADVISED** that on completion of these works the Chalderness Jetty and associated illuminated tide board will be permanently discontinued.

**MARINERS ARE REMINDED** that the navigable channel in this vicinity is marked by the buoyed channel.

**MARINERS ARE REQUESTED** to pass at slow speed to avoid creating a wash.
