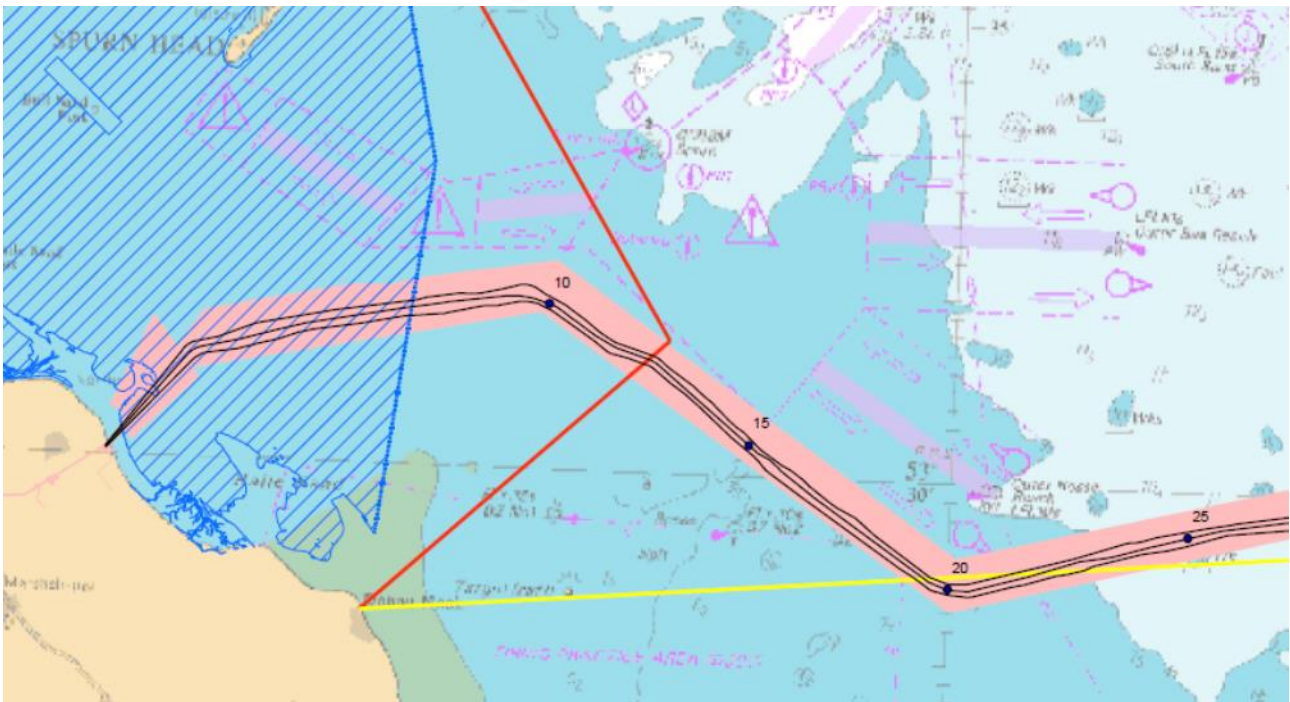

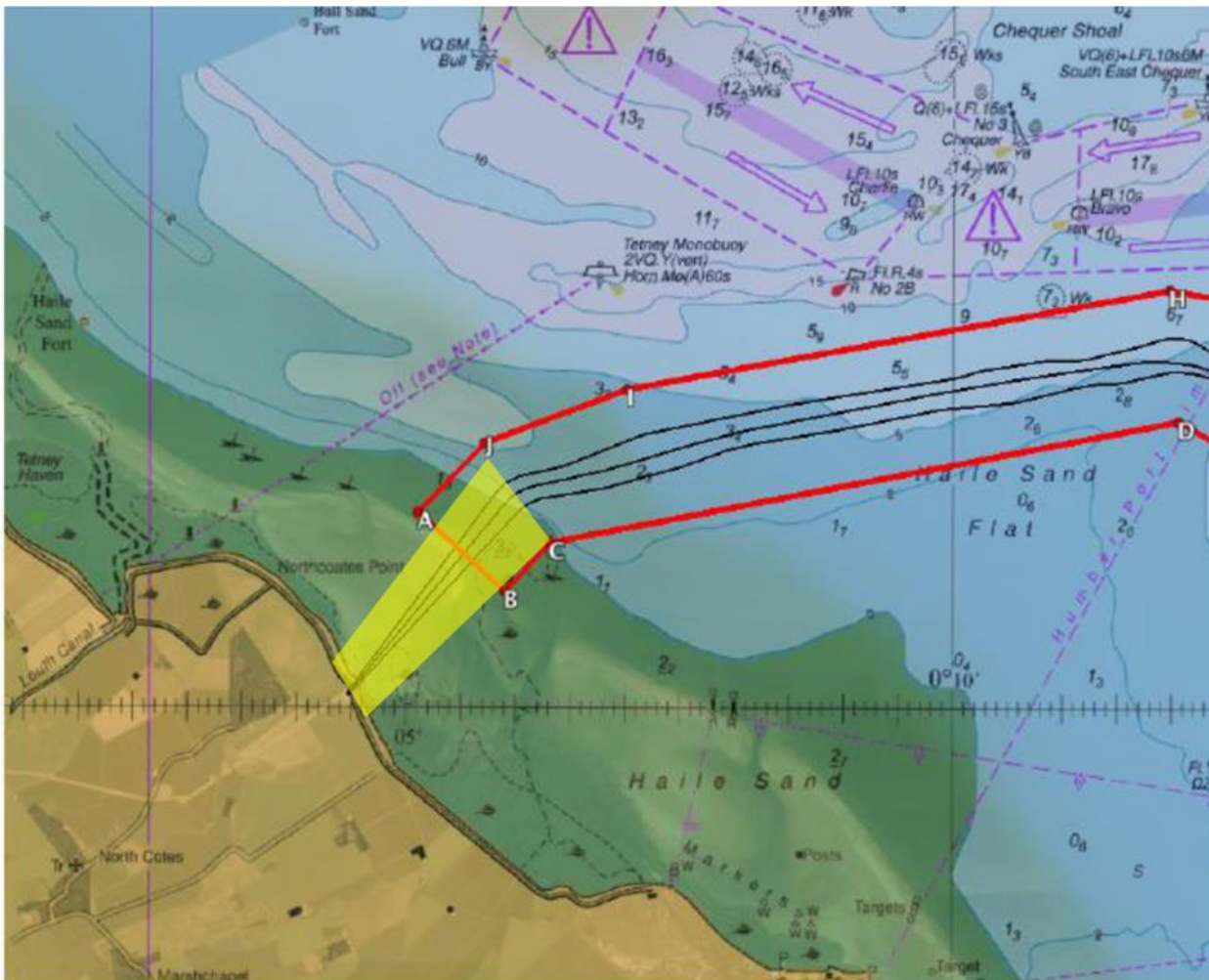
## HUMBER APPROACHES

### HORNSEA WIND FARM PROJECT ONE – CABLE LAYING OPERATIONS – WESTERN CABLE CORRIDOR

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that commencing Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) and continuing for a period of eleven weeks, cable laying operations on the western line will be carried out as part of the Hornsea Offshore Wind Farm (Project 1) throughout the corridor shown below.



Works will also be undertaken in the onshore intertidal area, as shown by the yellow highlighted section below.



The works will be carried out by a range of vessels including:

The vessels listed above will liaise closely with VTS Humber during the campaign, advising when vessels intend to move and any operations that are ongoing. They will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 14 and 16.

The cable laying vessel '**NDURANCE**' will be secured using a six point anchor system, and will be manoeuvring slowly through the movement of these anchors, as the cable is laid through the corridor.

**MARINERS ARE WARNED** that due to the limited maneuverability of the cable laying and works vessels, all other vessels unless operating as part of this project, are requested maintain a safe 500m distance. Additionally mariners are requested not to navigate within the 100m zone either side of the works in the onshore intertidal area, unless operating as part of this project. Finally, mariners are advised to pass at a reduced speed to avoid creating a wash.

Subsequent Notice to Mariners may be issued to cover further scopes of work associated.
