RIVER HUMBER

ALEX DOCK ENTRANCE, HULL – REMOVAL OF OBSTRUCTION

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that continuing for a period of approximately 2 weeks, diving and crane operations will be carried out to remove an obstruction in the entrance to Alex Dock, Hull.

Diving and crane operations will be conducted from the workboat “**FORTH DRUMMER**” (LOA 26.0m). The “**FORTH DRUMMER**” will hold her position by deploying two bow anchors and making fast with stern lines to the Eastern Approach Jetty, whilst operations are in progress.

MARINERS ARE REQUIRED to reduce speed in sufficient time to pass the dive site at slow speed with minimal wash.

MARINERS ARE FURTHER ADVISED that whilst diving and crane operations are underway there are no vessel movements into or out of Alex Dock. The “**FORTH DRUMMER**” will display the lights and signals prescribed in the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea, and will maintain a listening watch on VHF channels 12 and 16.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that Notice to Mariners H142/2016 is hereby cancelled.
