HULL MARINA TO SPURN POINT - SMALL CRAFT FLOTILLA

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that on Saturday 29th September 2018 a flotilla of more than forty small craft and historic sailing barges will proceed in formation from Hull Marina to Spurn Point.

The 30 metre sailing vessel '**HMS PICKLE**' will act as the lead vessel under the call sign 'Spurn Point Flotilla'.

The craft will depart Hull Marina at 0830 hrs and will proceed in formation along a route remaining to the north of the Foul Holme and Sunk Dredged channels.

At approximately 1230 hrs the flotilla will perform a medical evacuation exercise with HM Coastguard two cables to the north west of the Spurn jetty in position:

Latitude	Longitude
53° 34.79' N	000° 06.15' E

On completion of the medical exercise the flotilla will return to Hull Marina following its original route to the north of the channels.

The 6 metre RIB '**NICOLA 2**' will act as guard vessel and safety craft with a Police Launch assisting.

All craft in the flotilla will work VHF channel 08 for coordinating purposes and monitor VHF channel 12 at all times. Lead craft will inform VTS on commencement and completion of flotilla activities including transiting across shipping channels.

MARINERS ARE REQUESTED to keep a sharp lookout for this event and to exercise care and caution when navigating in the vicinity.
