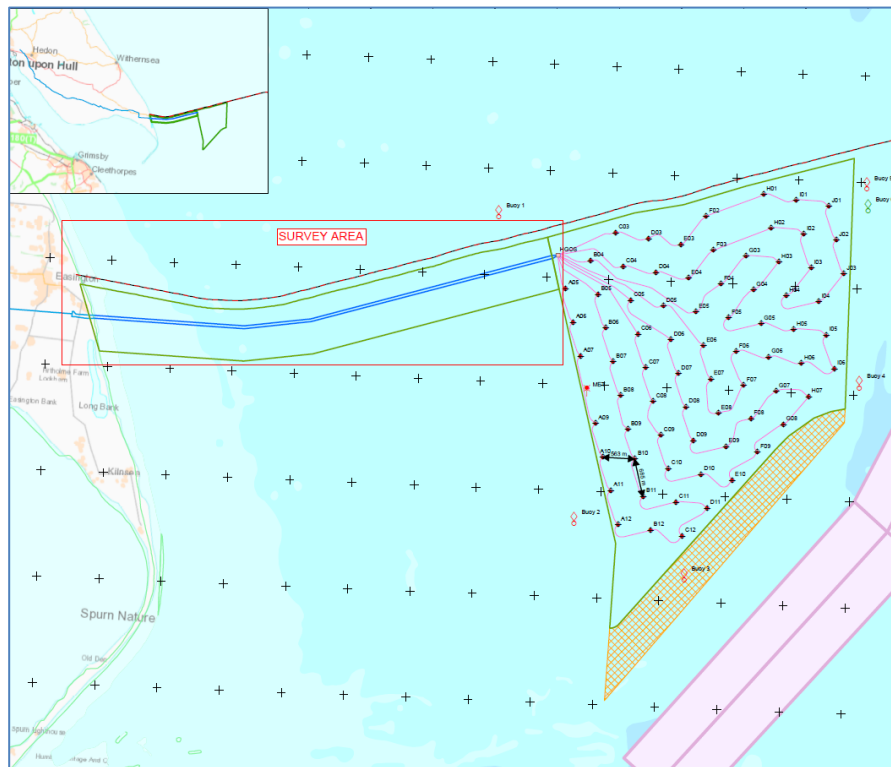

HUMBER APPROACHES

HUMBER GATEWAY WIND FARM - SURVEY OPERATIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that commencing Monday 30th September 2018 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) and continuing for a period of twelve days, geotechnical survey works will be taking place between the Humber Gateway Wind Farm and Easington as shown on the chart below:



Two vessels will be conducting the survey operations. The 68 metre research vessel 'VOS STAR' (call sign PDCT) will be using an ROV launched from the side of the vessel and the 9 metre diving support craft 'FAST FISHER' (call sign 2GGN4) will be towing a side scan sonar array astern of the vessel.

The 'VOS STAR' and 'FAST FISHER' will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 14.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED to pass at a reduced speed to avoid creating a wash and **ARE REQUESTED** to maintain a safe 500m distance.
