RIVER HUMBER

REMEMBRANCE DAY 2018

MARINERS ARE REMINDED that Sunday 11 November 2018 is the centenary of the end of the First World War.

The occasion will be commemorated with events across the United Kingdom and it is befitting that merchant ships in ports, anchored or moored within UK harbours are also included within this historic event.

That vessels berthed, anchored or moored in harbours are encouraged to use a commemorative sound signal, a single blast of 5 to 10 seconds' duration on the ship's whistle, at **1102 UTC**, **on Sunday 11 November 2018**. This sound signal will mark the end of two minutes silence, and vessels are encouraged wherever possible to take part.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that Harbour Authority approval is conditionally granted for any vessels wishing to participate, on the basis of visibility being greater than one nautical mile.
