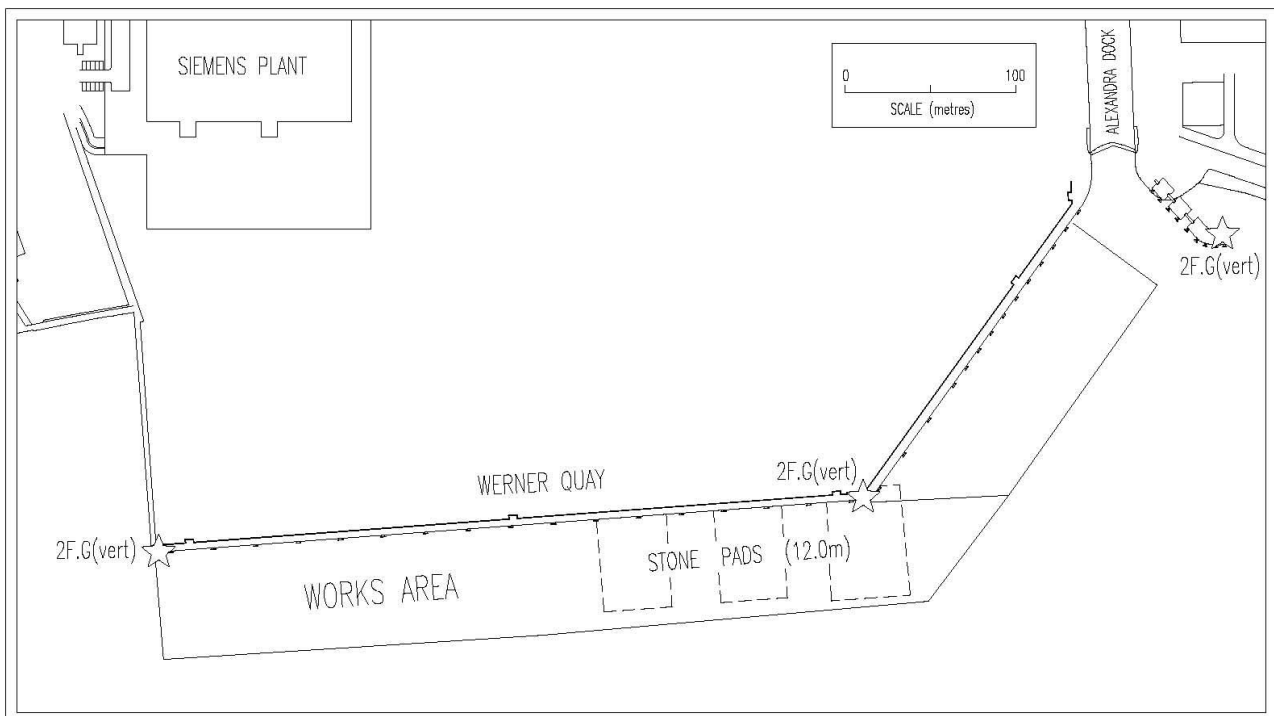

RIVER HUMBER

ALEXANDRA DOCK HULL – STONE BED INSTALLATION OPERATIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that commencing on Sunday 11th November 2018 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) for a period of four days, stone bed installation works will be conducted on the Western Approach Jetty at Alexandra Dock, Hull, as indicated on the diagram below.



The operation will be carried out by fallpipe vessel “**SIMON STEVIN**”, LOA 191m, beam 40m (callsign LXUB).

On completion of the stone bed installation a survey will be conducted by fast RIB “**FREEDOM**” (callsign PBQI) operating from Alexandra Dock, Hull.

The “**SIMON STEVIN**” and “**FREEDOM**” will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and, in addition, will keep a listening watch on VHF Channels 11, 12 and 16.

VTS will be contacted on commencement and completion of the works.

MARINERS ARE WARNED to exercise care and caution in the area and to pass “**SIMON STEVIN**” and “**FREEDOM**” at a REDUCED SPEED to avoid creating a wash.
