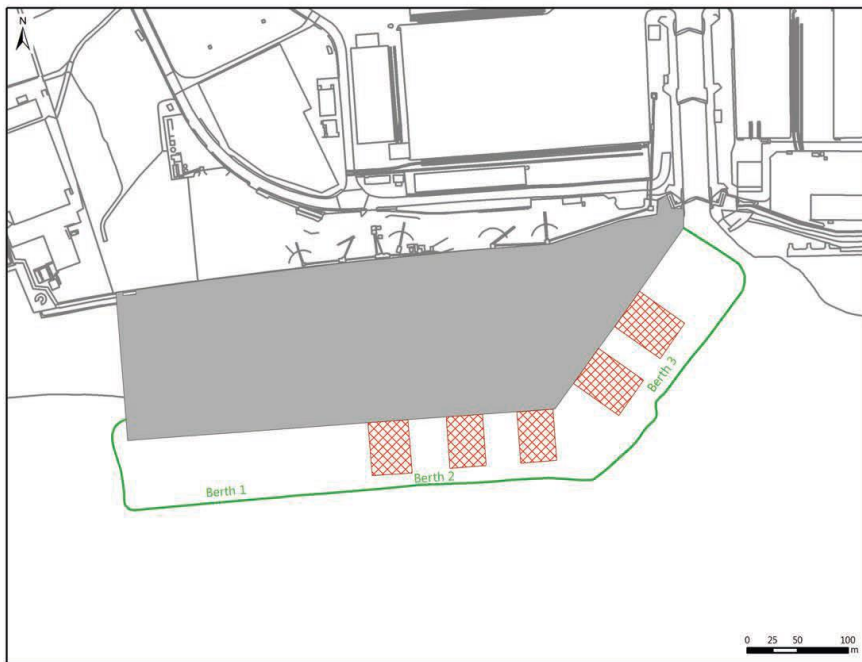

NOTICE TO MARINERS

ALEXANDRA, DOCK HULL – DREDGING OPERATIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that commencing on Monday 27 February 2017 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) for a period of three weeks, dredging operations will be conducted on the Western Approach Jetty and Werner Quay at Alexandra Dock Hull as indicated on the drawing below.



The dredging will be carried out by backhoe dredger “**MP 40**”, LOA 60m, who will during the dredge, maintain her position using spud legs. The spoil from the dredge will then be discharged into one of the following:

- Two Self-propelled spilt hopper barges “**SMMB1**” and “**SMMB3**”

The spoil will be transported to deposit ground HU056 (located North of Foul Holme Channel in vicinity of FH1 to FH3 buoys)

The dredging and discharge operations will be ongoing 24 hours a day during this period. Survey works in all the above areas will be via the tug “**F48**” conducting daily bathymetric surveys operating from Alexandra Dock.

All barges and vessels associated with the works will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and, in addition, will keep a listening watch on VHF Channels 11, 12 and 16.

MARINERS ARE REQUESTED to navigate with caution in the vicinity of these operations.

Please note that this notice is an addition to H54/2015.
