RIVER HUMBER

DISCONTINUATION OF PILOT BOARDING AND LANDING SERVICES AT RIVERSIDE QUAY, HULL

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that the service that allows vessels which are exempt from compulsory pilotage on River Humber but which require a pilot inbound or outbound for Rivers Trent or Ouse, and have historically boarded or landed a pilot at Riverside Quay, Hull, will be suspended until further notice.

Vessels that fall into this category of pilotage requirements will be required to board or land a pilot from the appropriate pilot boarding station at the seaward limits as referenced in Standing Notice No 4.

Boatage and line handling services required at Riverside Quay for other reasons should be arranged through the Dock Master, Hull.

This Notice will come into force at 2359 hours on 31st March 2019.
