

NOTICE TO MARINERS

U P P E R H U M B E R

MOVES OF FLOATING MARKS AND SHOAL WATER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that it is proposed on Monday 3rd April 2017 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) to move: -

- 1) The Lower Whitton Light Float to a position 315° T., 1033 metres from the South Ferriby Church Tower.

Latitude 53° 40.880' N, Longitude 0° 30.959' W (WGS 84)

- 2) The No. 33A Light Float to a position 028° T., 1075 metres from the Whitton Ness Beacon.

Latitude 53° 43.367' N, Longitude 0° 36.179' W (WGS 84)

- 3) The No. 32B Light Float to a position 343° T., 1193 metres from the Whitton Ness Beacon.

Latitude 53° 43.471' N, Longitude 0° 36.961' W (WGS 84)

The Lower Whitton Light Float will then bear 272° T., 736 metres from the No. 32 Light Float and 112° T., 1634 metres from the No. 32A Light Float.

The No. 33A Light Float will then bear 332° T., 991 metres from the Middle Whitton Light Float.

The No. 32B Light Float will then bear 283° T., 881 metres from the new position of the No. 33A Light Float and 073° T., 736 metres from the Upper Whitton Light Float.

MARINERS ARE WARNED that on completion of the above moves, the following shoal water will exist:-

- 1) A least depth of 0.2 metres below Chart Datum exists close North of the ships course from 450 metres to 580 metres upstream of the No. 34 Light Buoy.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that on completion of the above moves 0.1 metres below Chart Datum should be used for passage planning and Notice to Mariners No. H. 38/2017 will be cancelled.
