## RIVER TRENT

### COOLING WATER INTAKE/OUTFALL CLEARANCE AT KEADBY POWER STATION

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> April 2019 (or as soon after as circumstances permit), for a period of approximately 48 hours, cooling water intake/outfall clearance works will be carried out in the culverts North of Keadby Lock.

The crane barge **COLLINGHAM** (Loa 43.8m Beam 8.56m) and dredger **JOHN M** (Loa 35m Beam 8m) will carry out the works. The vessels will be moored alongside the outfall, and will be using a dredge pump to complete the dredge and dispersing the dredge material into the river.

The **COLLINGHAM** and **JOHN M** will be manned throughout and will maintain a listening watch on VHF channels 17 and 15.

**MARINERS ARE REQUIRED** to reduce speed when passing the **COLLINGHAM** and **JOHN M** to avoid creating a wash.
