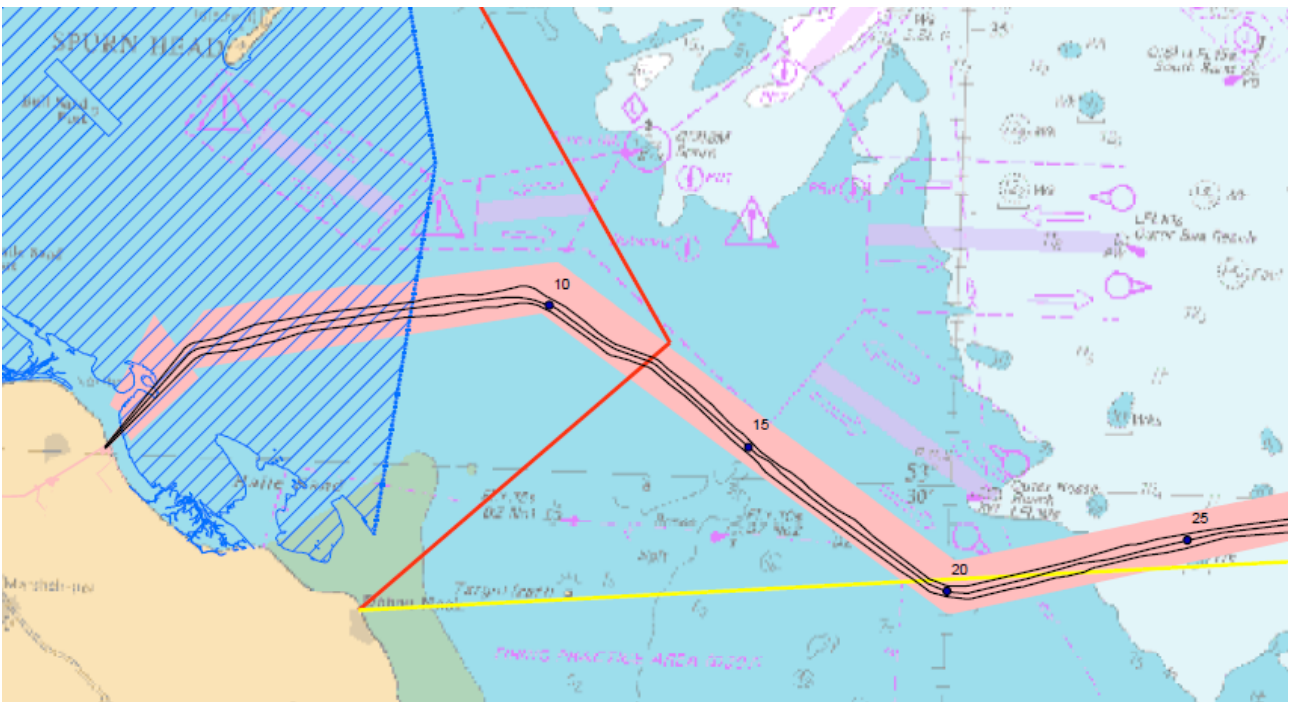

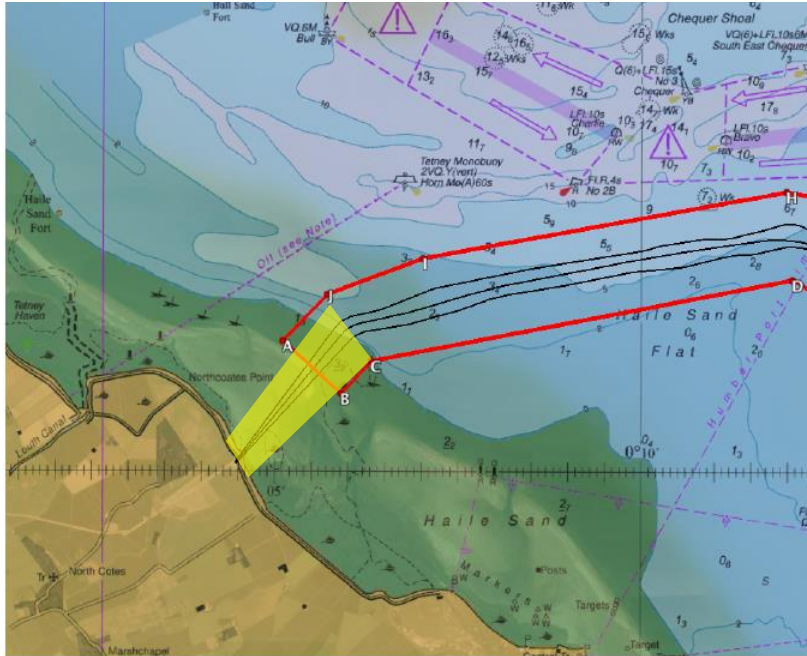
HUMBER APPROACHES

HORNSEA WIND FARM – CABLE LAYING OPERATIONS – ONSHORE INTERTIDAL WORKS PRECAUTIONARY AREA

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that commencing Sunday 01 April 2018 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) and continuing for a period of four months, cable laying operations will be carried out as part of Hornsea Offshore Wind Farm (Project 1) throughout the corridor shown below.



This Notice refers only to the onshore intertidal area, as shown on the diagram below in the yellow highlighted section, and which will be ongoing for the duration of the works.



The works in this area will be carried out by a range of vessels including:

The vessels listed above will liaise closely with VTS Humber during the campaign, advising when vessels intend to move and any operations that are ongoing. They will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 16 and 14.

MARINERS ARE REQUESTED not to navigate within the 100m zone either side of the works in the onshore intertidal area, unless for the purpose of; or in connection with; the construction, maintenance or operation of the authorised works. Additionally mariners are advised to pass at a reduced speed to avoid creating a wash.

Subsequent Notice to Mariners will be issued to cover further scopes of work associated with this project.
