WIND TURBINE BLADE INSPECTIONS

MARINERS ARE WARNED that Ørsted will be undertaking external blade inspections of the wind turbine generators at the Westermost Rough windfarm from the vessel **Captain P** using a remotely operated drone.

The works are planned to commence on 17th April 2019 with an expected completion date of 20th April, weather permitting.

MARINERS ARE REQUESTED to exercise caution in the area and to take a wide berth around **Captain P**. For safety purposes there is a requirement to implement a **minimum advisory safety distance of 100m** around the wind turbines and also the **Captain P** whilst the drone is in flight.

A listening watch will be maintained on VHF Channel P1 frequency 157.450MHz by the Westermost Rough Offshore Coordinator who can be contacted for information relating to vessel movement.
