## ALEXANDRA DOCK HULL, GREEN PORT HULL CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on Monday 11 May 2015 (or as soon after as circumstances permit), until further notice, continuous construction works will be carried out on the Eastern and Western Approaches to Alexandra Dock, including Reservation Quay, as part of the Green Port Hull project.

The scope of works will include piling and construction works being done from the waterline using a number of vessels.

These vessels will liaise closely with VTS Humber and the Alexandra Dock Marine Control Centre (VHF Ch. 9 & 11) during the campaign advising on commencement and completion of any operations. They will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 16 and 12.

Any vessels destined for or departing from Alexandra Dock, shall consult with the Alexandra Dock MCC with respect to any works that are being carried out prior to manoeuvring on arrival or departure from the berth.

MARINERS ARE REQUESTED to reduce their speed to a maximum of 5 knots through the water when transiting the area between the No. 22 Hook buoy and No. 24 Lower West Middle, to avoid creating a wash, when advised by VTS Humber that works are in progress. This limit includes vessels approaching / departing Alexandra Docks, Hull.
