THORNGUMBALD TO SKITTER HAVEN – GAS PIPELINE SURVEY OPERATIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that commencing Saturday 20th May 2017 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) and continuing for a period of about 3 days, survey operations will be carried out over the gas pipelines crossing the River Humber between Thorngumbald and Skitter Haven.

The 10 metre survey vessel '**EGS WATCHFUL**' will be engaged in the work, and when underway may have equipment streaming close alongside or at a distance of up to 50 metres astern. The vessel will be running survey lines both along and across the pipelines over the full width of the river.

The '**EGS WATCHFUL**' will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 16 and 12.

MARINERS ARE WARNED to exercise care and caution in the area and to give the '**EGS WATCHFUL**' and its tow as wide a berth as possible, passing at the **SLOWEST POSSIBLE SPEED** to avoid creating a wash.
