MIDDLE BURCOM – SUNKEN VESSEL SURVEY

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that following an extensive multi beam survey of the Navigable Channel from Sunk Spit to the Lower Burcom, no trace can be found of the wreck of the pleasure craft “**PEGGOTTY**”, which sank on 19 May 2016. Sightings of associated debris have since been reported across the estuary and beyond the Humber area.

MARINERS ARE REQUESTED to continue to report any sightings of debris or pollution to VTS Humber.

MARINERS ARE FURTHER ADVISED that Notice to Mariners H.52/2016 is hereby cancelled, and normal traffic flows can be resumed.
