MOVES OF FLOATING MARKS AND SHOAL WATER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that it is proposed on Friday 20th April 2018 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) to move: -

- 1) The Cappers West Light Float to a position 212° T., 1696 metres from White Pile, Melton.

Latitude 53° 41.840' N, Longitude 0° 34.175' W (WGS 84)

(203 metres South East of its current position)

- 2) The Middle Whitton Light Float to a position 094° T., 948 metres from Whitton Ness Beacon.

Latitude 53° 42.821' N, Longitude 0° 35.782' W (WGS 84)

(236 metres North East of its current position)

- 3) The Upper Whitton Light Float to a position 334° T., 1238 metres from the Whitton Ness Beacon.

Latitude 53° 43.455' N, Longitude 0° 37.140' W (WGS 84)

(69 metres South East of its current position)

- 4) The No. 32C Light Buoy to a position 282° T., 1293 metres from the Whitton Ness Beacon.

Latitude 53° 43.007' N Longitude 0° 37.789' W (WGS 84)

(109 metres South South West of its current position)

The Cappers West Light Float will then bear 281° T., 892 metres from the No. 31 Light Float and 134° T., 949 metres from the No. 33 Light Float.

The Middle Whitton Light Float will then bear 317° T., 1589 metres from the No. 33 Light Float and 154° T., 1047 metres from the No. 33A Light Float.

The Upper Whitton Light Float will then bear 269° T., 468 metres from the No. 32B Light Float.

The No. 32C Light Buoy will then bear 221° T., 1096 metres from the new position of the Upper Whitton Light Float and 053° T., 754 metres from the No. 34 Light Buoy.

MARINERS ARE WARNED that on completion of the above moves, the following shoal water will exist: -

- 1) A least depth of 0.5 metres **ABOVE** Chart Datum exists North of the ships course 280 metres downstream of the Lower Whitton Light Float.

Deeper water exists on and to the South of the ships course in this vicinity.

- 2) A least depth of 0.3 metres below Chart Datum exists on the ships course from 194 metres to 344 metres upstream of the No. 33A Light Float.

Deeper water exists to the North of the ships course in this vicinity.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that on completion of the above moves 0 metres at Chart Datum should be used for passage planning purposes and Notice to Mariners No. H. 61/2018 will be cancelled.
