SURVEY OPERATIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a trawl survey will be taking place at the following location:

- South East side of Redcliffe Sands (53°41.7'N 0°29.8'W) on Monday 20th May, between 1945 and 2115.

The 6m RIB '**HULL UNI ONE**' (call sign MJTF9) will be engaged in the work, and will be required to conduct six trawls at this location. The trawl itself will consist of a 1.5m beam trawl net, which will be streamed approximately 25m from the stern of the vessel. The trawl run will be 300m in length.

MARINERS ARE ALSO ADVISED that in addition, the '**HULL UNI ONE**' will also be conducting a seine survey in the following location:

- South East side of Redcliffe Sands (53°41.7'N 0°29.8'W) on Monday 20th May, between 1430 and 1615.

This survey involves streaming a 30m long seine net out from the sandbar and back to form a horseshoe, before hauling the net back in and will need to be completed three times.

The '**HULL UNI ONE**' will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 15, 12 and 16.

MARINERS ARE WARNED to exercise care and caution in the area of the survey and to pass the '**HULL UNI ONE**' at a REDUCED SPEED to avoid creating a wash.
