ESSENTIAL DIVING MAINTENANCE ON INTAKE GATES AT KEADBY POWER STATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Monday 3rd June 2019 (or as soon after as circumstances permit), for a period of approximately 5 days, divers will be carrying out essential maintenance on the intake gates at Keadby Power Station.

The multicat **SCOTT H** (Loa 14m Beam 6m) will act as diving support and rescue vessel and will be on station during diving operations. The crane barge **COLLINGHAM** (Loa 43.8m Beam 8.56m) will be carrying out the intake gate lifting operations.

The diving operations will be conducted daily between 0800 and 1800.

The **SCOTT H** and **COLLINGHAM** will be manned throughout and will maintain a listening watch on VHF channels 17 and 15.

MARINERS ARE REQUESTED to contact **SCOTT H** prior to approaching the operating area.

MARINERS ARE FURTHER REQUESTED to reduce speed when passing the **SCOTT H** and **COLLINGHAM** to avoid creating a wash.
