MOVES OF FLOATING MARKS AND SHOAL WATER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that it is proposed on Thursday 15th June 2017 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) to move: -

- 1) The No. 33 Light Float to a position 112° T., 1625 metres from the Whitton Ness Beacon.

Latitude 53° 42.526' N, Longitude 0° 35.274' W (WGS 84)

- 2) The No. 33A Light Float to a position 024° T., 1357 metres from the Whitton Ness Beacon.

Latitude 53° 43.522' N, Longitude 0° 36.129' W (WGS 84)

- 3) The No. 32C Light Buoy to a position 274° T., 2548 metres from the Whitton Ness Beacon.

Latitude 53° 42.966' N, Longitude 0° 38.951' W (WGS 84)

- 4) The No. 34 Light Buoy to a position 258° T., 3204 metres from the Whitton Ness Beacon.

Latitude 53° 42.494' N, Longitude 0° 39.489' W (WGS 84)

The No. 33 Light Float will then bear 325° T., 914 metres from the Cappers West Light Float and 142° T., 867 metres from the Middle Whitton Light Float.

The No. 33A Light Float will then bear 341° T., 1232 metres from the Middle Whitton Light Float and 089° T., 914 metres from the No 32B Light Float.

The No. 32C Light Buoy will then bear 242° T., 1469 metres from the Upper Whitton Light Float.

The No. 34 Light Buoy will then bear 214° T., 1058 metres from the new position of the No. 32C Light Buoy and 052° T., 1015 metres from the No. 42 West Walker Dyke Light.

MARINERS ARE WARNED that on completion of the above moves, the following shoal water will exist: -

A least depth of 0.2 metres below Chart Datum exists close South of the ships course 320 metres downstream of the No. 34 Light Buoy.

Deeper water exists on and to the North of the ships course in this vicinity.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that on completion of the above moves 0 metres at Chart Datum should be used for passage planning and Notice to Mariners No. H. 73/2017 will be cancelled.
