MOVES OF FLOATING MARKS COMPLETE

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that the Upper Humber moves of floating marks as detailed in Notice to Mariners No. H.77/2016 have been successfully completed.

The No. 32B Light Float has been reinstated and should once again be included in passage plans. The temporary ships course from the Middle Whitton Light Float to the Upper Whitton Light Float should now not be used.

The remaining Skitter Channel buoy move (NTM No. H.76/2016) will be carried out as soon as is practicable.

MARINERS ARE FURTHER ADVISED that 0.3 metres below Chart Datum should be used for passage planning and Notice to Mariners No. H.78/2016 is hereby cancelled.
