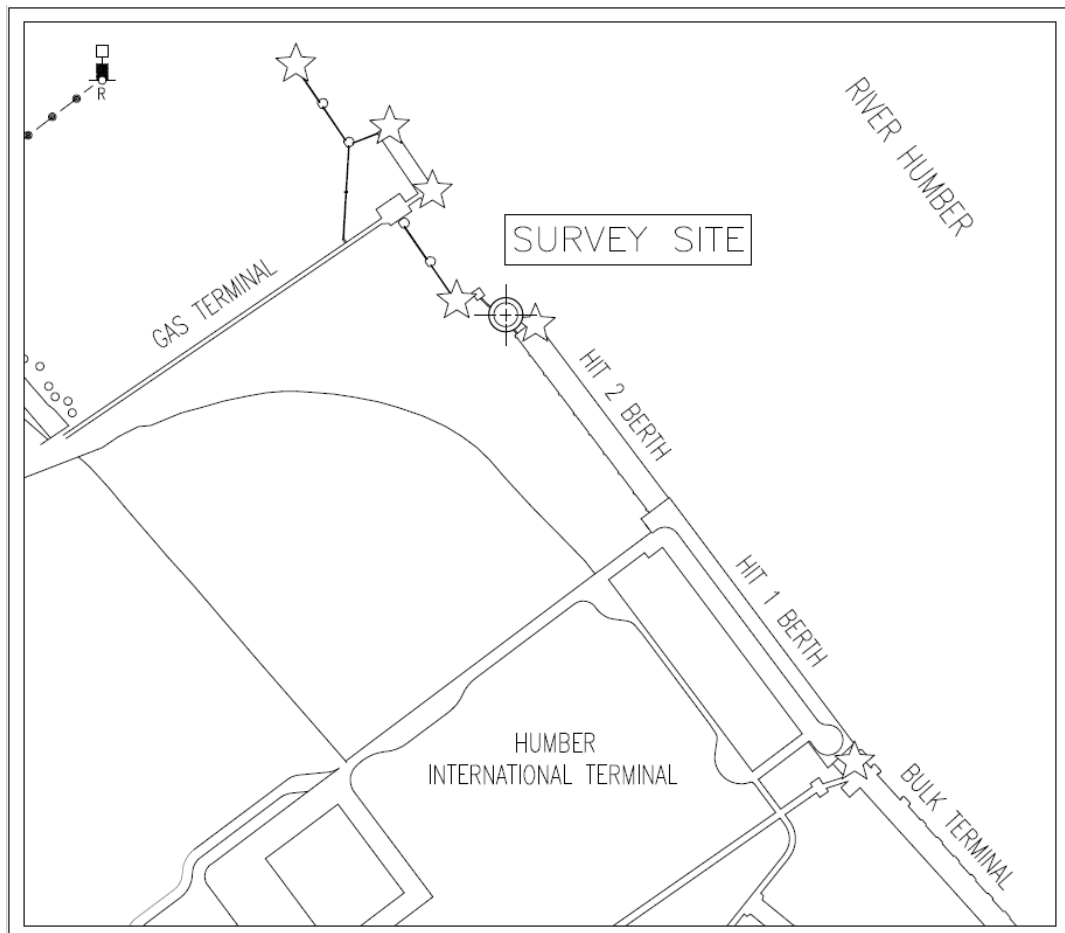

IMMINGHAM – SURVEY EQUIPMENT DEPLOYMENT

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that on Friday 5th June (or as soon after as circumstances permit) a survey seabed frame will be deployed for a period of approximately three months in the following position:

Latitude 53° 38.655' N Longitude 0° 12.276' W (WGS 84)



The survey seabed frame will be placed at a depth of 4 metres below chart datum and will be deployed inside the line of the jetty face and tethered to the western end of Humber International Terminal Berth 2.

The operation will be undertaken by the vessel “**UKD SEAHORSE**” which will display the lights and signals prescribed in the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will liaise with VTS Humber and maintain a listening watch on VHF channels 12 and 68.

MARINERS ARE REQUIRED to navigate with caution in these areas.
