MOVES OF FLOATING MARKS AND SHOAL WATER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that it is proposed on Friday 25th May 2018 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) to move: -

- 1) The Middle Whitton Light Float to a position 098° T., 838 metres from the Whitton Ness Beacon.

Latitude 53° 42.796' N, Longitude 0° 35.887' W (WGS 84)

(48 metres South West of its current position)

- 2) The No. 33A Light Float to a position 026° T., 1308 metres from the Whitton Ness Beacon.

Latitude 53° 43.493' N, Longitude 0° 36.130' W (WGS 84)

(166 metres North North East of its current position)

The Middle Whitton Light Float will then bear 313° T., 1638 metres from the No. 33 Light Float.

The No. 33A Light Float will then bear 348° T., 1319 metres from the new position of the Middle Whitton Light Float and 095° T., 498 metres from the No. 32B Light Float.

MARINERS ARE WARNED that on completion of the above moves, the following shoal water will exist: -

- 1) A least depth of 0.4 metres **ABOVE** Chart Datum exists close North of the ships course 331 metres downstream of the Lower Whitton Light Float.

Deeper water exists on and to the South of the ships course in this vicinity.

- 2) A least depth of 0.1 metres **ABOVE** Chart Datum exists North of the ships course 170 metres upstream of the No. 32C Light Buoy.

Deeper water exists on the ships course in this vicinity.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that on completion of the above moves, 0 metres at Chart Datum should be used for passage planning purposes and Notice to Mariners No. H. 85/2018 will be cancelled.
