RIVER TRENT

MESSINGHAM - EXPOSED GAS PIPES

MARINERS ARE WARNED that a survey carried out on the 16th June 2020 shows the following: -

Two gas pipelines (which are normally buried) have become exposed above the river bed in the vicinity of Messingham, approximately 1800 metres upstream of West Butterwick, in the following position:

- 53° 31.576 N, 00° 44.266 W (WGS84)

A least depth of 1.7 metres below Chart Datum exists to the Western side of the river.

Deeper water exists to the Eastern side of the river in this vicinity.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that works to re-bury the pipes will be carried out as soon as is practicable.

MARINERS ARE REQUIRED to navigate with caution and **not anchor** in the vicinity of the gas pipes.
