WHITTON ISLAND LAGOON PROJECT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that commencing Monday 24th July 2017 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) and continuing for a period of about 4 weeks, construction operations will be begin on Whitton Island to create an RSPB water bird habitat and lagoon.

Construction equipment including an excavator and fuel bowser will be transported to the island via the Humber Workboat '**Mortlift**' and will be delivered and removed over two tides at the start and finish of the project.

During the project a twice daily launch run will be conducted by '**THELDAR**' to ferry personnel from Whitton Village to Whitton Island and back.

The '**THELDAR**' and '**MORTLIFT**' will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 15 when in operation.

MARINERS ARE WARNED to exercise care and caution in the area and pass at the SLOWEST POSSIBLE SPEED to avoid creating a wash.
