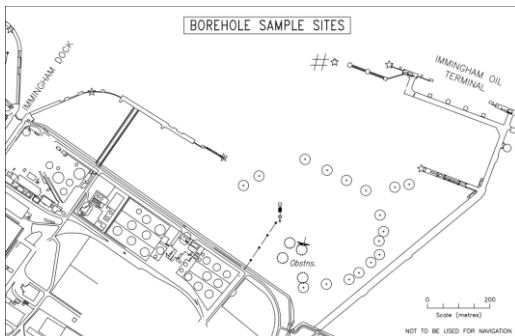

SEABED INVESTIGATION WORKS – IMMINGHAM OIL TERMINAL TO IMMINGHAM EASTERN JETTY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that commencing on Saturday 7th January 2023 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) and continuing for a period of two months, seabed investigation operations will be carried out between the Immingham Oil Terminal and Immingham Eastern Jetty as shown below: -



The work will involve the jack-up barge '**SKATE 3E**' (LOA 19m, Call Sign J8B5005) conducting bore hole seabed investigations and being towed to different locations by the tug '**WILLSUPPLY**' (LOA 20m, Call Sign 2EAZ3)

The '**SKATE 3E**' and '**WILLSUPPLY**' will display the lights and signals prescribed in the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF channels 12 and 69.

MARINERS ARE REQUESTED to contact the Immingham Assistant Dock Master on VHF channel 68 prior to commencing manoeuvring within the immediate Immingham vicinity and the Immingham Oil Terminal on VHF channel 69 for IOT finger pier operations.

MARINERS ARE FURTHER REQUESTED to exercise care and caution and give the area as wide a berth as possible, passing at the SLOWEST POSSIBLE SPEED to avoid creating a wash.
