UPPER HUMBER, OUSE AND TRENT

SURVEY OPERATIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that commencing Thursday 5th September 2024 (or as soon as circumstances permit) and continuing for a period of 12 weeks, survey operations will be carried out between:

- The M180 bridge on the River Trent to the Apex;
- The M62 bridge on the River Ouse to the Apex;
- And the Apex to the Humber Bridge.

The 8-metre survey vessel '**SENTRY III**' (callsign MFQH3) will be engaged in the work and will be running survey lines at 250m intervals over the full width of the river.

The '**SENTRY III**' will exhibit the lights and shapes prescribed by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channels 14, 15, 16 and 17, and is equipped with AIS.

MARINERS ARE WARNED to exercise care and caution in the vicinity of the survey vessel.
