GRIMSBY APPROACH CHANNEL – UPDATE TO DREDGING OPERATIONS

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that dredging operations continue in the Grimsby approach channel as per Notice to Mariners No. H. 178/2022 and will continue for an approximate period of six weeks.
