**IMMINGHAM OIL TERMINAL – SURVEY EQUIPMENT
DEPLOYMENT**

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that commencing on Friday 12th August (or as soon as circumstances permit) a survey seabed frame, with attached marker buoy will be deployed to the east of the Immingham Oil Terminal in position:

Latitude 53° 37.580' N Longitude 00° 09.081 (WGS 84)

The survey seabed frame will be attached to a sinker weight and subsequently marked by a yellow marker buoy with a top mark of a yellow cross, with light characteristics **FL.Y.3s**. The buoy will be in position for approximately 12 months.

The device will be deployed by the vessel “**UKD SEAHORSE**”. Once deployed the buoy will be serviced regularly throughout its deployment period.

MARINERS ARE REQUIRED to navigate with caution in this area.

The “**UKD SEAHORSE**” will display the lights and signals prescribed in the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will liaise with VTS Humber and maintain a listening watch on VHF channels 12 and 16.
