RIVER TRENT

ESSENTIAL MAINTENANCE DREDGING ON INTAKES AT KEADBY POWER STATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Wednesday 14th September 2022 (or as soon after as circumstances permit), for a period of approximately 24 hours, essential maintenance dredging will be carried out on the intakes at Keadby Power Station.

The crane barge 'COLLINGHAM' (Loa 43.8m Beam 8.56m) will carry out the dredging works. The vessel will be moored alongside the intakes and will be using a side cast grab to complete the dredge and disperse the dredge material into the river.

The 'COLLINGHAM' will be manned throughout and will maintain a listening watch on VHF channels 17 and 15.

MARINERS ARE REQUESTED to contact 'COLLINGHAM' prior to approaching the operating area.

MARINERS ARE FURTHER REQUESTED to reduce speed when passing the 'COLLINGHAM' to avoid creating a wash.
