## R I V E R H U M B E R

### SOUTH EAST CHEQUER LIGHT FLOAT OFF STATION – TEMPORARY REPLACEMENT WITH VIRTUAL AID TO NAVIGATION

**MARINERS ARE WARNED** that the South East Chequer Light Float is off station and has been replaced with a temporary virtual aid to navigation in position:

Latitude: 53° 33.358' N    Longitude: 0° 12.860' E

Characteristics: VQ(6)+LFL.10s

**MARINERS ARE ADVISED** that the light float has been recovered for further inspection and will be returned to station as soon as circumstances permit.

Until the light float can be replaced, a temporary virtual aid to navigation will be broadcast by AIS and will appear on AIS chart plotters, RADAR with AIS input and Pilots' PPU's to aid navigation until the mark is physically replaced.

**MARINERS ARE REQUIRED** to exercise extreme care and caution when navigating in this vicinity.
